This is a 5-day experience with ample work time. We will be observing nature, drawing, and planning, designing compositions and choosing a color palette. I will be demonstrating painting techniques and offering advice throughout the sessions.

Whether you are into abstract expression or traditional painting or everywhere in between... painting from your heart and with your focus on the fun of creating, this painting class will let you find your "Happy Place!"

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Robin Douglas has taught art for 48 years at every level and venue - including 36 years as an Art Professor at the School of Art and Design at the University of Illinois-Champaign Urbana. She taught many studio and



art history courses and ranked excellent by her students.
